## Nalani Vickers, Sapphire class

It is with great sadness that I write to tell you that Nalani Vickers (who was a pupil in your child's class in year 3) passed away last week after a short illness. Our thoughts are with her family and we have sent them our deepest sympathy and offered support on behalf of the school community.

We know that Nalani had many friends within the class and I am sure they will especially miss her. We have not been able to tell and support the class in our normal way due to the current restrictions. If you tell your child this news please allow a space for them to quietly reflect on this sad news. I know that you will understand that at this time people will be experiencing many different feelings in their responses to this loss. This is to be expected and we would ask you to bear with us through this time.

We know that children will be distressed by this news. Whilst Nalani's death was not COVID related, this news may add to children's anxiety during these uncertain times and they may or may not want to talk about this with you. I know that you will take this time to listen to them and provided a familiar and supportive routine. We will make sure that there are opportunities for the children in Sapphire class to talk about their feelings with their teacher Erin and the Year 4 staff when we return after half term.

Nalani joined Deptford Park in Year 1. She was a kind and thoughtful girl who made friends quickly.

These are worrying times. If you are feeling overwhelmed or just need to talk to someone, please do not be afraid to ask for help. You can call the school office or e-mail us at any time. There are many organisations you can reach out to if you want to have a confidential chat, including Child Bereavement UK who have produced leaflets for children and young people who have experienced bereavement.
