Dear parent,

Arrangements for positive Coronavirus test reporting

As we come to the end of an eventful term, I just wanted to take a moment to contact you all to say thank you, to wish you well, and to confirm some of the practical details around managing cases and test results during the Easter break.

Since the emergence of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic in March 2020, schools have played a key role in continuing to serve communities by implementing 'contain' measures whenever a positive case has been identified in school. Thankfully, so far, this has only resulted in two bubble closures.

As we approach the Easter break, we hope it is helpful just to outline the requirements for children who test positive during this break.

When school closes for the Easter break we will put our system in place to continue implementing 'contain' measures.

What should you do?

If your child attends this school and tests positive for Covid 19:

- You will need to tell us by telephoning the school and leaving a message on the Covid line.
- Please leave your child's name, class and the first day they showed symptoms.
- Please leave in your message as much of the information as you can using the Confirmed Case Form. (See attached)

This will allow us to work with families to contact trace in order to 'contain' the spread of the virus where necessary during Easter break.

The main symptoms of coronavirus are:

- a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature);
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual);
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

Most people with coronavirus have at least 1 of these.

We are therefore asking families to:

- let us know immediately if your child develops COVID symptoms;
- arrange for a test;
- inform us of the test result as soon as you are aware of it (results are usually provided within 24 hours)


