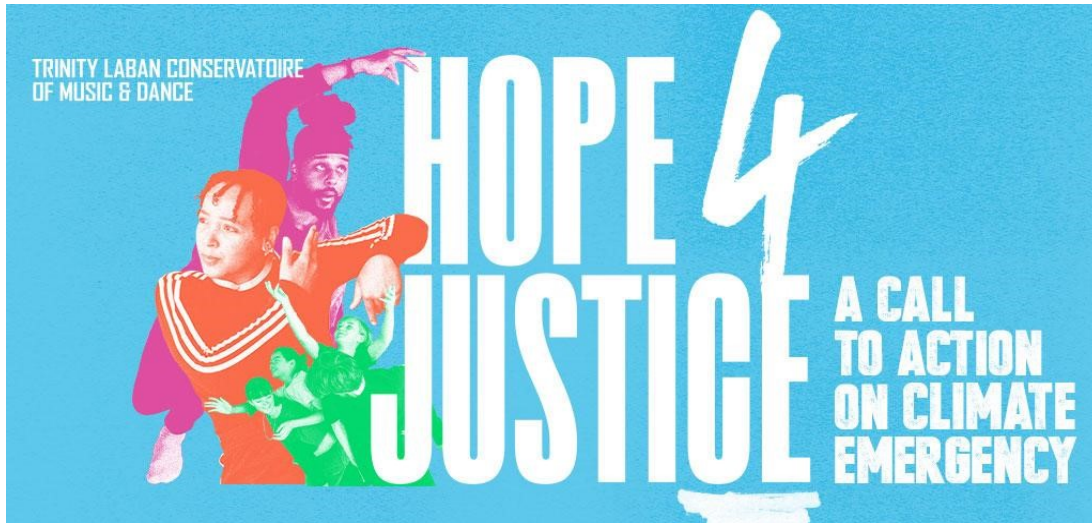


This letter has been updated with information about drop off, pick up and what to bring on the day



Dear Families,

Your child is performing in [Hope 4 Justice](#), a music, dance and spoken word performance involving over 1,000 young people, from 26 local schools, about the climate emergency.

Created and produced by Trinity Laban in collaboration with leading artists and local young people, the socially-engaged project is a key part of the Mayor's London Borough of Culture 2022 celebrations.

Your child has been learning their part in school time. We will be taking your child to an onsite rehearsal at Mountsfield Park on Friday 17th June within school time. Please bring a packed lunch and full water bottle, and a waterproof jacket if it is raining/sun cream if it is hot on this day.

**Performances:** 3pm and 4.30pm

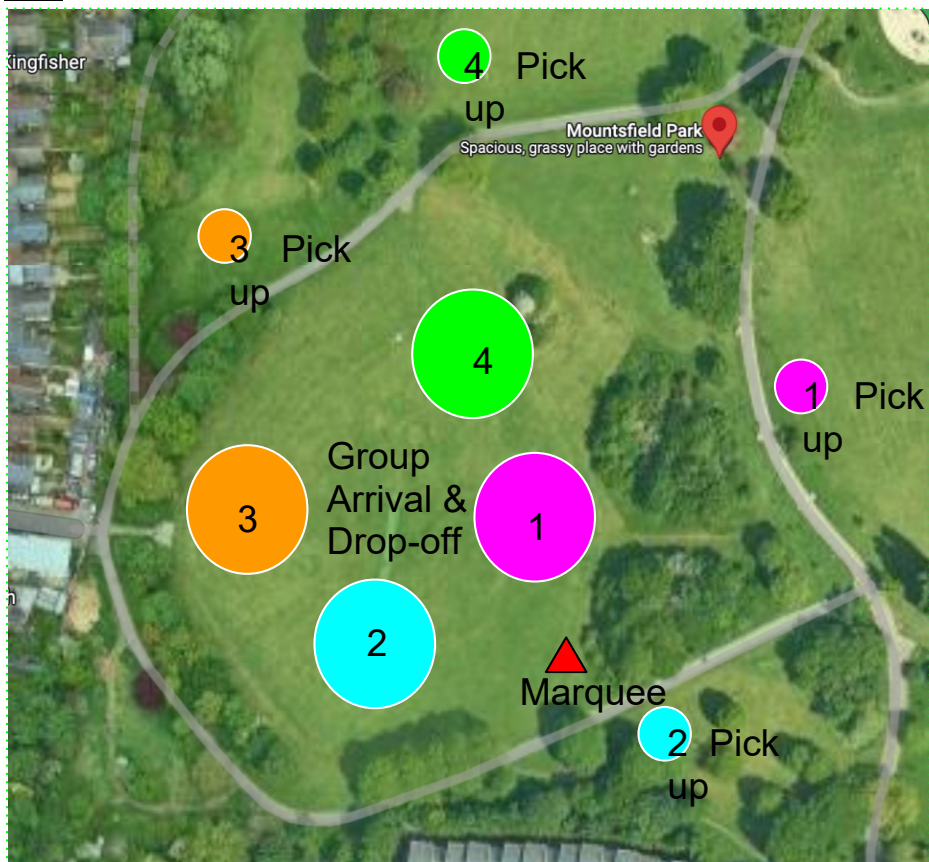
**Tickets:** We hope you'll watch your child's performances.

### Arrival Location

Please take your child to the Cricket field in Mountsfield Park to the area which corresponds with their group colour, to register with your lead school staff member (see map above):

### **Food, Drink and What to Bring:**

Please bring ONE LABELED BAG containing food, snacks and a refillable water bottle. Please aim for your child to have eaten their packed lunch by the time they register. Participants will not be able to go off-site to purchase food. We will provide a way for you to refill your water throughout the day.

It will be a particularly physical and high-energy day, so you may want to pack more food than usual. **NO NUTS OR PRODUCTS CONTAINING NUTS** can be brought to the event.

Performers' bags will be stored in a secure area, supervised by a security guard. Please do not bring valuables to the event.

**Wet Weather and Suncream:**

Before attending the park, please check the weather forecast. If the weather is due to be wet, please bring a labeled waterproof jacket with you. Please remember to bring SPF 30+ sun cream, a labeled hat and lightweight shirt/jumper to shade yourself from the sun during breaks.

**Costume:** Our school is wearing clothing that is **ORANGE** for our costume. We need to wear as much **ORANGE** as possible, and the rest of our outfit can be a combination of white, grey and black.

All clothes must be loose, comfortable and easy to move in. No jeans. Shoes must be trainers or plimsolls. These can be any colour.

Please do not buy any new clothes: we encourage you to borrow from friends, family and wider community, or you could organise a clothes-swap in school. If you absolutely need to buy, please go second hand at a charity shop. We can help if you are stuck.



We encourage you to match the colour in the swatch above, but also understand if you need to wear another shade.
