Mindfulness and cognitive control

The capacity to stay in the driver's seat is what scientists call **cognitive control** and the skill of paying attention to the right thing at the right time is critical.

Cognitive control is the ability to keep your focus on one thing and ignore distractions. It is also called **learning readiness** and **impulse control**.

We can strengthen the brain circuitry typically associated with cognitive control through practice. Every time you bring your attention to the point of your focus, every time you notice your mind has wandered, like you do during a Mindfulness practice, you strengthen those neural networks.
